**Note: This is a Double Run format trial. Any class offered twice in a day will run the same course twice with no second walk through.**

**Entries are now open. Closing date is Saturday, Oct. 15 (as postmarked) or earlier if entry limit is reached. After the closing date, entries will be accepted at the Day-of-Entry fee rate until run limit is reached.**

**GAMES** – All are straight forward numbered classes with each showcasing a specific set of skills. For example Touch N Go highlights contact performance. Come out and try them. Your dogs will love them.

**ENTRY CHANGES and MOVE-UPS:** You must notify the trial secretary no later than the Tuesday prior to the start of the trial if you wish to make changes to your original entry. The **Saturday to Sunday move-up** period will close 30 minutes following the trial's conclusion on Saturday. A binder will be at/near the ribbon table to record move-up requests.

**REFUNDS/CANCELLATIONS:** Full refunds will be issued for cancellations received prior to pre-closing date of Oct. 17<sup>th</sup>. A withdrawal from the trial after closing date due to an injury and/or illness to the dog will be eligible for a refund up to 75% of the total entry fee paid. A veterinarian's notice of injury or illness will be required for a refund. Bitches which come in season before Thursday of the trial week will be eligible for a refund up to 75% of the total entry fee paid. You must notify the Trial Secretary no later than that Thursday. There shall be no refunds for entries in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal.

**NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:** (PAC = Palomar Agility Club)

- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations including, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial. Download Exhibitors Handbook at [www.nadac.com](http://www.nadac.com)
- **\*\*Dogs must be registered with a valid NADAC registration number before entries will be accepted.**  
On line registration available at [www.nadac.com](http://www.nadac.com)
- Excused from trial: (In such case, no fees shall be refunded).
  - Please note that NADAC trials strive to provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
  - Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial site.
  - Any dog which the judge feels is not in enough control to perform all obstacles in a safe manner will be excused from the agility trial.
  - It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the organizing committee, be asked to leave the trial site. Safety shall always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers and their guests.
  - Dogs are to be kept away from horses and other livestock that may be on the property.
- All dogs must be on leash when not competing in the ring, and must be contained unless being prepared to run.
- All crates and exercise pens are to be setup only in designated areas. Exhibitors must stay within designated areas.
- Please help keep entire site clean, clean up after your dog(s) everywhere on the property, clean up your setup area.
- The organizing committee may refuse any entry on the basis expressly provided through NADAC rules and regulations or guidelines established by NADAC. Competitors not currently in good standing with NADAC or PAC may not entry.
- Checks (or other forms of payment) not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$35.00 service charge for any returned check.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- This is a **Containerized Trial** – Food or a small noiseless toy may be carried into the ring in your pocket provided it is contained in a Ziploc bag or small container such as a pill bottle. The container cannot be visible in the ring nor within 10 feet of the ring. You cannot indicate to your dog that you have this item on you i.e. patting your pocket. You are not allowed to remove the container until you are at least 10 feet outside the ring. All food and toys must be contained at the trial and none can be left lying about loose. This policy has been implemented to reduce the possibility of dogs fighting over loose food or toys, diminish dogs dragging their handlers back to their crates (or wherever they left their food), and to lessen the amount of insects that are around loose food.
- **THE MANAGEMENT** will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is expressly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of any NADAC or PAC representative, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

**DIVISIONS, LEVELS, AWARDS**

- Veteran Dogs – Dogs between 7 and 9 years of age may enter the Veteran Division. As of their 9th birthday they MUST enter Veterans for all jumping classes, and after their 12th birthday the dog must enter as Skilled Veterans. (Veterans Division for jumping classes and Skilled Category for non-jumping classes.)
- Veteran and Disabled Handler (VH): Disabled handlers or handlers aged 60 yrs. or older may opt to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive additional standard course time. This division is for handlers only. The additional SCT is only for those who may need the time to negotiation the course due to physical limitations. When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all classes and all dogs in this division for the weekend.
- Junior Handlers (JH): 17 years old or younger
- Intro Level -Courses are shorter than Novice courses. Jump heights can be chosen by the handler without regard to the dog's height, with 16" being the maximum. There are no contact/tunnel discriminations & no weave poles except in Intro Weavers which has one set of six.

- Final confirmations and trial information will be emailed after the trial's closing date. Please be sure your email address is complete and easily read.
- **AWARDS** - PAC will award ribbons to 1st through 4th place in each jump height, class and category, except Chances (a pass/fail class), qualifying ribbon for each qualifying run, new title ribbons and NATCH poles. Please let us know in advance if you may receive a special award so we may celebrate with you. Also awarding High-in-Trial certificates.

**IMPORTANT** Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately. NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to [www.NADACForum.com](http://www.NADACForum.com) list within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the NADAC Forum by going to [www.NADACForum.com](http://www.NADACForum.com) and submitting your request. Your dog's points can be found in the Members Section. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC. Levels Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be recorded by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

**DIRECTIONS TO SITE:** RV's see alternate route below.

Please do not drive RVs up the narrow dirt drive between the 1<sup>st</sup> ring and dog runs. Park in the dirt lot just south of the 1<sup>st</sup> ring. Narrow alley, low branches, limited turn around area, and fire regulations.

- **From I-15 Southbound:** Exit on Centre City Pkwy. Turn left at West El Norte Pkwy. Turn left at East Valley Pkwy. Next, turn right on to Lake Wohlford Rd. Go approximately 5.2 miles to 26417 N Lake Wohlford Rd. Make a sharp turn right onto downhill dirt driveway.
- **From I-15 Northbound:** Exit on Via Rancho Pkwy, which becomes Bear Valley Pkwy, continuing until it ends at East Valley Pkwy Turn right onto East Valley Pkwy. Next, turn right on to Lake Wohlford Rd. Go approximately 5.2 miles to 26417 N Lake Wohlford Rd. Make a sharp turn right onto downhill dirt driveway.
- **From CA-78 East:** CA-78 becomes E. Lincoln. Continue on E. Lincoln Ave. Turn right on El Norte Pkwy, continuing to East Valley Pkwy. Turn left on East Valley Pkwy. Next, turn right on to Lake Wohlford Rd. Go approximately 5.2 miles to 26417 N Lake Wohlford Rd. Make a sharp turn right onto downhill dirt driveway.
- **Alternate RV Route:** After turning left (north) on to East Valley Pkwy, drive about 4 miles past Lake Wohlford Road; up and over the summit. Near the bottom of the grade, turn right at the light on to Woods Valley Road. Follow Woods Valley Rd about 4 mi. until it intersects w/ North Lake Wohlford Road. Turn right (south) at stop sign, drive approx. 0.7 mile to 26417 N Lake Wohlford Rd, turn left (east) onto the downhill dirt driveway.

**Special #2: Welcome Back to PAC.** PAC also wants to welcome back handlers that have not competed at a PAC trial since January 1, 2015 by offering them a \$60.00 per day welcome special. This special is valid only for returning handlers, new dogs under a handler that has not be away since Jan. 2015 are not eligible.  Returning JH, \$30.00/day.
